HIGHLAND WHISKY

GLENMORANGIE 10 YEAR OLD SINGLE MALT £3.30

Yellow gold in colour with a rich nose & flowery, spicy hints including vanilla wood notes. The taste confirms the nose, a delicate honey wood taste with a subtle hint of nuttiness. The finish is smooth & relatively long.

HIGHLAND PARK 12 YEAR OLD SINGLE MALT £3.30

A healthy glowing amber colour with heather-honey sweetness & peaty smokiness on the nose. Taste is rounded, smoky & sweet with full malt delivery. The finish is teasing, heathery & delicious.

GLENFIDDICH 12 YEAR OLD £3.95

This signature single malt Scotch whisky has matured for at least 12 years in American and Spanish oak casks. Characteristic sweet, fruity notes. Develops into elements of butterscotch, cream, malt and subtle oak flavour. Long smooth and mellow finish.

GLENFIDDICH 15 YEAR OLD £4.25

Silky smooth, revealing layers sherry oak, marzipan, cinnamon and ginger. Full bodied and bursting with flavour. Satisfyingly rich finish with a lingering sweetness.

GLENFIDDICH 18 YEAR OLD £4.60

A robust single malt that richly delivers luxurious dried fruit, candy peel and dates overlaid with elegant oak notes. Warming, rewarding, and highly distinguished finish.

ISLAY WHISKY

ARBEG 10 YEAR OLD SINGLE MALT £4.00

Jim Murray's 2008 World Whisky of the Year. The aroma is a mix of toffee and chocolate sweetness, cinnamon spice and medicinal phenols. With water, the depth of the peat opens up revealing layers of phenols, peat, leather and a whiff of wood smoke. The palate offers an initial moderate and clean sweetness of deep peat notes, with tobacco smoke and strong espresso coffee followed by treacle sweetness and liquorice. A smoky sweetness is left on the palate.

BRUICHLADDICH 12 YEAR OLD SINGLE MALT £4.00

Fully matured in bourbon casks and lightly peated whisky with a sappy oak finish. On the nose you get gentle peat and quite coastal, light and fruity aromas. Originally, Bruichladdich intended to keep this expression going for a few years, but they ran out of stocks only after a year and a half.

ISLAY WHISKY

LAGAVULIN 16 YEAR OLD SINGLE MALT. £4.70

Deep amber gold whiskey with intense peat smoke, iodine & seaweed. A rich, deep sweetness & a full body. Dry peat smoke fills the palate with a gentle but strong sweetness, followed by sea salt with touches of wood. Finish is long, smooth, elegant & peat-filled with lots of salt & seaweed.

LAPHROAIG 10 YEAR OLD SINGLE MALT. £3.55

Gold in colour with a huge smokey, seaweedy, "medicinal" nose. The body is full & the taste surprises with sweetness, hints of salt & layers of peatiness.

SPREYSIDE WHISKY

MACALLAN 10 YEAR OLD SHERRY OAK £3.30

Pale Gold with a hint of sweet toffee balanced with dried fruits & sherry. The taste is smooth with dried fruits, sherry sweetness & wood smoke & finished with dried fruits, sweet toffee & a hint of wood spice.

GLOBAL AND BLENDED WHISKEY

JAMESONS £2.95

Smooth drinking, light bodied Irish Whiskey with a touch of cereal and honey sweetness on both the nose and the palate. It has a touch of burnt wood and caramel on the back of the tongue, as well as a slight touch of clove.

NORTH AMERICAN AND BOURBON

JACK DANIELS £2.95

On the nose Jack Daniels offers gentle aromas of caramel, vanilla, and butterscotch. A hint of wood is apparent and toffee notes begin to appear in the glass as it opens up. a smooth smoky sweetness on the palate. Jack Daniel's Black Label offers a quick, sweet finish. Oak notes, a hint of spices, and perhaps a touch of cedar mingle with a warm caramel finish that gives way to white pepper and walnuts.



NORTH AMERICAN AND BOURBON

JIM BEAM RED STAG

£2.95

A Hint of black cherry for Bourbon that's anything but subtle. Distinctively fruity, without disguising the familiar, rich nose of Jim Beam bourbon. Corn sweetness and mellow oak accented by a hint of black cherry for smoothness and balance. The finish is satiny and sweet, with true bourbon warmth.

JIM BEAM

£1.95

Jim Beam bourbon undergoes distillation at lower temperatures and is distilled to no more than 62.5%. The nose is quite sweet with gentle notes of vanilla and cut hay, a touch of fresh cornfields and a little cereal sweetness, like the bluegrass fields of Kentucky. The palate is of good body with notes of toasty oak and all the requisite notes of vanilla and crème anglaise, a little spice and pepper with an acetone note. The finish is of toasty oak and resin with some sweetness.

MAKERS MARK

£2.95

An old faithful bourbon. Makers Mark never lets you down and being from the wheat school always shows good oak balance. Aroma with delightful strands of exotic fruit and honey. A lush, pleasingly deep and malty palate and a firm nuttiness adds extra oily, chew ability to the toffee. Caramel toffee with the oak guarantees a bittersweet edge.

KNOB CREEK

£3.30

Bottled at an honest 100 proof like all good bourbons were a century ago, Knob Creek Bourbon is aged nine years, giving it the distinction of being aged the longest of the Small Batch Bourbons. This extra aging allows it to absorb more of the sugar in the wood, giving it a slightly sweeter taste and nose. Rich, sweet, woody, full-bodied and almost fruity with aromas of toasted nuts, grain and oak and a long, rich and glowing finish.
